Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)

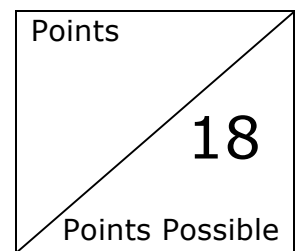

Testing Directions for Teachers:

Beginning at the top, read the Scripture reference to the student. Continue down the page in order. Divide student's total points by points possible for percentage. Eighty percent required to pass.
