And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.

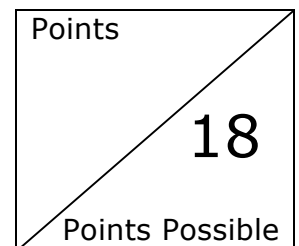

Testing Directions for Teachers:

Continue down the page in order. Divide student's total points by points possible for percentage. Eighty percent required to pass.
